2012 Annual Meeting Minutes

Agenda Items Covered:

1. Establishment of quorum - Between the proxies and attendees (Amy Harding, Woody Davis, Dori Boulden, Adam Grimm (Telephone)) the quorum was established. Also in attendance was Sheryl Bryant (Summit Management Company).
